put this on


you can fill in fields, save template, and load it select more or all photos to put iptc in all photo. Write all selected.

some options- tools options F12


comment was inserted

handy if comment was set with faststone


Adding comment is easiest in faststone, press D to add jpeg comment (stored in jpeg.date stays same)



with settings in faststone (F12) you can set an edit program, press E starts that program with your selected photo



in xnview you can search (ctrl-F) in several fields



In photoshop CS, under file > file info you can enter under 'Description' some metadata about the picture. (see in attachment picture IPTCinCS01.jpg). This is stored (as IPTC?? have to find this out, seems to be correct) within the picture.


It seems to be part of Dublin Core properties (which is good, [www.dublincore.org](#) uses this also for IMDI) (see in attachment IPTCinCS02.jpg).

Disadvantage of using this method is the high amount of system resources needed by Photoshop. So it may not be the fastest method if yor pc is slow.
